FINANCES

Invoices for the 2023 Road Rates will be with you shortly, if you haven't already received them. At the last AGM it was agreed that fees for 2023 would be £130 and that a 5% charge would be added to any fees that remain unpaid from previous years.

A financial report will be presented at the AGM in March 2023 and queries can be addressed to our Treasurer at any time.

SGN Works update

At the time of writing, SGN have notified the estate of work to replace gas mains in Southdean Drive, Greenway and Rose Avenue. Residents in Southdean Drive and Greenway have had individual notification of the works and a start date. SGN have advised that , due to additional work being required in the Shrubbs Field area, work in Southdean Drive is likely to be delayed by two weeks.

The chairman is in communication with SGN and will attempt to make sure that, although disruption is inevitable, it is kept to a minimum.

COMMITTEE MATTERS

The committee have recently been focussed on sorting out the estate maintenance, improving the estate signs, producing an updated resident's booklet, introducing a GDPR (Data Protection) policy, arranging a Christmas social event, and arranging a beach clean.

ESTATE MAINTENANCE

Hopefully you will have all noticed the excellent work that Paul Westwood has been doing around the estate, clearing the twittens of weeds and other debris, and repairing and repainting the entrance to Rose Avenue. Repainting the gate at the entrance to Southdean Drive and the stile at the entrance to the twitten are on the list of things to do when the weather improves, and time allows.

SPEEDING

A beach clean was organized at the end of the school holidays, on Sunday 11th September at 10:00am. Resident's Booklet

An updated Resident's booklet was produced and distributed in November to all houses on the estate. If you haven't seen a copy, please ask your road representative for one. As with all printed things, it was out-of-date almost before printing, with the Beresford Public House sadly shutting its doors.

Despite proof-checking, it has also been noticed that the Greenway road representative is missing from the committee list; the Greenway road representative remains Nick Trish.

As previously mentioned, Renate Waller has stepped down from the committee and a new representative for Shaw Close will be appointed after the AGM.

GDPR (Data Protection Policy)

We are pleased to advise that the Southdean Estate is now compliant with the requirements of the data protection act. A central database of residents is accessible only to committee members, by authorization from the chairman, and no details will be shared with any external source without the prior permission of residents.

A separate database, with financial details, is held by the Southdean Estate bookkeeper and is only otherwise accessible by the Treasurer.

Christmas Social

A Christmas Social was held at the Middleton Sports Club on Thursday 15th December and a very enjoyable evening was had by all. More than 50 tickets were sold for the event, although sickness reduced the actual attendance to 49 on the night. A raffle was held which raised £155 for the RNLI and our thanks go to all who donated the prizes and those who bought the tickets. The following was received from the RNLI:

PARISH COUNCIL UPDATE

West Sussex County Council have cleared the flood water and drains on the junction of Middleton Road, Elmer Road and Yapton Road 3 times and have now sent down a CCTV camera which has identified that the drains have sunk and have root incursion. As a result there will have to be a major repair job undertaken at some point. Unfortunately until then, the flooding issue will continue when we have heavy down pours. The recent rain has caused many major problems around the county including a landslide on the main north/south road through Pulborough closing that road and Pagham has been underwater for weeks now because of the collapse of

roadside ditches and the need for a new surface water drainage system. This will mean that we are down the list of works, and it might take a while to get something done. My apologies.
